Master of the modern legal thriller, John Grisham visits Pace Academy to talk about his most recent work, *The Associate*, and his only nonfiction work, *The Innocent Man*.

*The Innocent Man* tells the story of two men who spent years in prison for a crime they did not commit. DNA evidence proved their innocence.

Grisham comes to Atlanta at the invitation of the Georgia Innocence Project (GIP), a nonprofit organization that uses DNA testing to prove the actual innocence of the wrongfully-convicted. Tickets to this event are tax-deductible donations to GIP.
